Class 3 will develop their coding skills, how to stay safe online and designing their own spreadsheets.

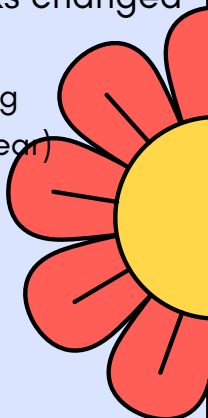
