## What is Teach the Future?

## How was Teach the Future started?

17-year-old Joe Brindle and a group of likeminded students launched the Teach the Future in October 2019 with the aim to raise awareness of climate change in education and support positive change. Teach the Future is a youth-led campaign ran entirely by students!

Joe believes most people his age "want to understand more about climate change and what's behind it, the issues of justice... and the politics behind it".
