Reading at Holme Slack

RESPONSIBLE RECORDING

If your child reads at home then it is their responsibility to record this in their Reading Record. It doesn't matter what your child is reading, it may be a magazine, a poem, an audio book with subtitles or our school e-books, we want to know about it!

Your child can write in the name of the book or even draw a picture to show us they have read.



Children may collect 1 read per night and can therefore collect a total of 7 reads per week, this is also 35 Class Dojo points!

With every 25 reads your child will receive a badge and certificate in our Friday celebration assembly. We encourage our Readers to wear their badges with pride!

Those children who collect all of our 6 badges will receive an extra special badge for that academic year.
