Every Thursday in small groups, we explore our local area, visiting shops and places of interest.

Our Learning in Maths

Know that the last number reached when counting a small set of objects tells you how many there are in total ('cardinal principle').

Count objects, actions and sounds.

Subitise to 5. Link the number symbol (numeral) with its cardinal number value

Count beyond ten.

Compare numbers – linked to 5 & 6

Understand the 'one more than/one less than' relationship between consecutive numbers – linked to $5\ \&\ 6$

Automatically recall number bonds for numbers 0 to 5

Have a deep understanding of number to 10, including the composition of each number

Verbally count beyond 20, recognising the pattern of the counting system

Comparing quantities up to 10 in different contexts, recognizing then one quantity is greater than, less than or the same as another quantity

Automatically recall number bonds up to 5

Explore and represent patterns within numbers up to IO, including odds, double facts and how quantities can be distributed equally

Key Vocabulary: Number Bond Doubling Odd Even
