Maths

Know that the last number reached when

counting a small set of objects tells you how many there are in total ('cardinal principle').
Count objects, actions and sounds.

Link the number symbol (numeral) with its cardinal number value.

Count beyond ten.

Compare numbers – linked to 9 & 10.

Understand the 'one more than/one less than' relationship between consecutive numbers – linked to 9 & 10

Automatically recall number bonds for numbers 0 to 5

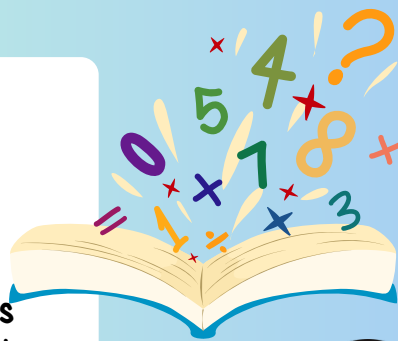
Have a deep understanding of number to 10, including the composition of each number

Verbally count beyond 20, recognising the pattern of the counting system
Comparing quantities up to 10 in different contexts, recognizing then one quantity is greater than, less than or the same as another quantity

Subitise up to 5

Automatically recall number bonds up to 5 and some number bonds to 10, including double facts
Explore

and represent patterns within numbers up to 10, including odds, double facts and how quantities can be distributed equally
