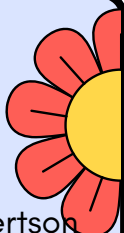
Welcome back to school - here is an overview for this term

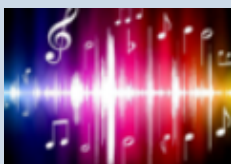


Maths

This term in Maths, the children will be focusing on learning and applying their 3, 6, 9 and 7 times tables. They will be using these known facts to solve related division calculations and explore number patterns linked to the times tables.

Science

Our topic in Science this term is 'Sound'. The children will be learning how sounds are made and how they travel through different materials as vibrations. They will investigate how pitch and volume can be changed and explore how the ear works to help us hear. The children will also carry out practical enquiries to test how distance and materials can affect the way sound is heard.



PE

In PE this term, the children will be working on gymnastics, developing their health-related fitness. They will also be learning invasion game skills through basketball, focusing on movement, teamwork and ball control.

English

This term, the children will be exploring a range of genres in English, including:

- A narrative adventure inspired by The BFG
- A film and playscript based on The Plague
- A non-chronological report arguing for a ban on social media for under 13s
- An information poster explaining how digestion works



PSHE

In PSHE this term, our theme is 'Living in the Wider World'. The children will be learning about belonging to a community, the different people who help and support it, and how we can show care and compassion towards others. They will also explore how information is shared online, how adverts can influence people and how to stay safe and responsible when using digital media. Later in the term, the children will learn about money and work, including making sensible spending choices, keeping money safe, different ways to pay for things and learning about different types of jobs.

RE

In R.E this term, the children will be learning about how Sikhs show their beliefs and commitments through their actions and through symbols that represent their faith.. The children will also continue to learn about Christianity.



Music

Children will learn changes in pitch tempo and Dynamics. They will also learn Haiku music and performance

Design & Technology

Children will be creating an electrical System. Simple circuits and switches (including programming and control)

Art

In art they will be exploring Still Life. They will explore artists working with the genre of still life, contemporary and more traditional.

History

In History this term; the children will be learning about the Romans, exploring who they were, how they lived and the impact they had on Britain. They will investigate how they invaded and conquered new lands, and what life was like for people living under Roman rule. .

Geography

In Geography this term, the children will be learning about rivers. They will explore what a river is, how rivers are used and the key features that make up a river. They will look at how rivers can be affected by humans, the impact of flooding.

French

In French, the children will be learning language related to birthdays, including numbers, months and how to say their age.

Computing

In Computing this term, the children will be learning about programming by using repetition to create and control shapes. They will also be exploring data logging by collecting, recording and interpreting data using digital tools.
