A huge thank you for your incredible generosity in supporting our Harvest Food Collection. Your donations will be delivered to the Salvation Army, where they will be distributed to families and individuals in our local community who need them most. We are so grateful for your kindness and support.

Thank you also for supporting our ongoing attendance drive, which remains a key priority for the school this year. Good attendance is one of the most important factors in helping children succeed. Every day at school matters, and even small amounts of missed learning can quickly add up.

A reminder that holidays taken during term time cannot be authorised except in exceptional circumstances. Current regulations mean that parents may receive a penalty notice if a child has 5 days of unauthorised absence. Please also be aware that unauthorised absences are cumulative. For example, 4 unauthorised days followed by a further day later in the year can still result in a penalty notice. In addition, fines may now be issued when a child accumulates 10 unauthorised sessions of absence within a 10-week period.

We would also like to remind families that children arriving at school after 9:20am receive an unauthorised absence mark for that session. By this point, children have already completed a significant part of the morning, including their phonics lesson, which can have a considerable impact on learning, confidence and progress, particularly for our younger pupils.

We know that every family's circumstances are different, and we are committed to working together to overcome any barriers to attendance. If there is anything affecting your child's attendance or punctuality, please speak to us. We are here to help.

As always, teamwork makes the dream work. Thank you for your continued support in ensuring every child has the very best opportunity to thrive. ✨

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CLASS FOCUS - YEAR 2

Year 2 have had another fantastic week of learning across the curriculum! In Art, the children explored continuous line drawing using pine cones as still-life objects, creating some brilliant observational artwork. In Writing, they revisited alliteration and began applying it independently to make their writing more exciting and engaging. Maths lessons focused on placing numbers accurately on blank number lines and spotting mistakes, while in Mastering Number the children used counters and tens frames to explore doubles. In Geography, they became geographers by designing their own maps with human and physical features and creating keys. We also practised spellings each morning, using our phonics knowledge to help us. In PE, the children developed their ball control skills and continued creating their explorer dances. At Forest School, they enjoyed getting creative with grass, making sculptures and nests, and safely exploring the inside of conkers using palm drills. It has been a busy week full of creativity, problem-solving and fantastic learning!
