Tuesday and Thursday

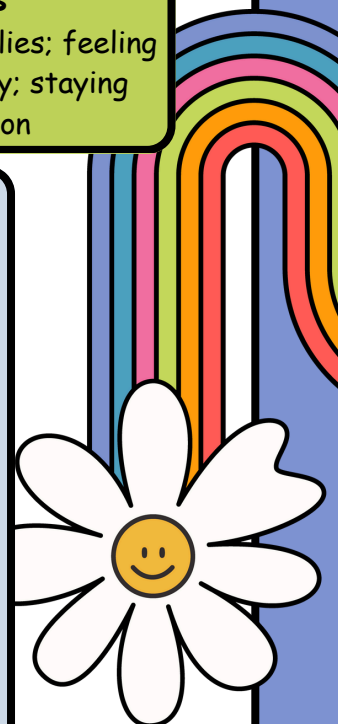
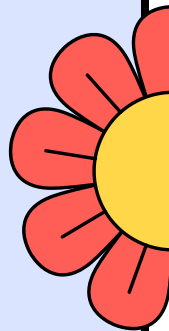

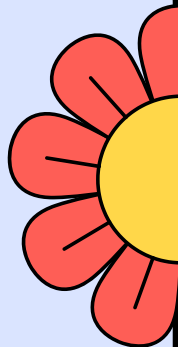
