Welcome back to school - Happy New Year and welcome back.

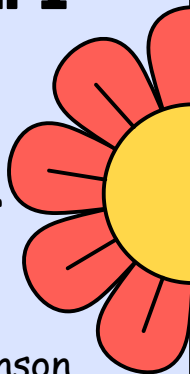

Science

This term we are looking at **animals including humans, and Plants.**

This term Mrs Wyn will be teaching religious education - her specialist area. We will be covering- Islam and Judaism.

Music

In music the children will be learning about **rhythm**, they will take part in class performances and playing the glockenspiel.

English

We are learning about stories language, information texts, labels, lists, captions and poetry. Throughout these units the children will be given lots of opportunities to work on their writing skills, learning to recognise when capital letters and full stops are required. Books covered: On the way back home!, The Bear and the Piano and On Safari.

Maths

This term we will be focusing on comparing quantities, part-whole relationships and how we can group numbers together, 3D and 2D shapes. There will be lots of opportunities for the children to use practical equipment to secure this knowledge.

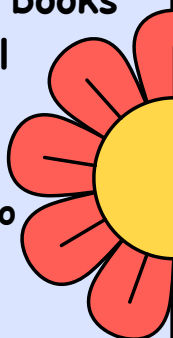
