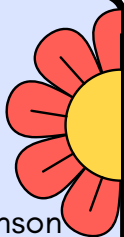
Welcome back to school- here is an overview for this term

Maths

This term in maths, the children will learn how to multiply and divide using a range of methods. They will also investigate and develop their understanding of: area and scaling, calculating with decimal fractions, factors, multiples and prime numbers.

Science

Our topic in Science this term is 'Earth and Space'. The children will be learning about the eight planets in our solar system, how they orbit the sun and how the moon orbits Earth. They will investigate time zones and seasons in relation to the position of Earth in comparison to the Sun.



PE

This term, children will continue to develop key skills of resilience, tactics and game sense. This will be incorporated through badminton, creative games, gymnastics and football.

English

During this term, we will be covering the following genres:

- Science fiction narrative based upon the book 'Cosmic'
- A non-fiction transmission from Mars
- A newspaper report based upon the sinking of the Titanic
- A narrative continuing on the beginning of 'The Lion above the Door'

RE

The unit of work this term will be focused on Hinduism, looking specifically about what Hindus learn from stories about Krishna. The children will also continue to learn about Christianity.

Music

Children will learn songs and music which originates from South and West Africa and composition based upon the festival of colour.

Design & Technology

Children will be creating a structure using wood. The children will be measuring, cutting and assembling their wooden structures.

Art

In art, we will be focusing on creating landscapes and cityscapes using a range of different materials.



History

Our new topic is the Vikings. There is a lot to cover including:

- Where the Vikings lived
 - The Viking raids on Britain
 - Famous Viking explorers
 - The establishment of Danelaw
- The children will also be developing their historical skills including, chronology enquiry and interpreting sources and communication.

Geography

The class will be learning all about Greece this term. They will be identifying Greece on a map, looking at the impact tourism has on Greece and identifying the physical and human features of the country.

Computing

In computing, Year 5 will be using a 3D printer to create a project that they have designed. They will also learn how to create vector drawings on their iPads.

French

After learning how to greet people and give information about ourselves or others, this term, we will be learn French terms for parts of the body and language to describe their families.
