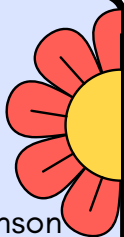
Welcome back to school- here is an overview for this term

Maths

This term, the children will be developing their understanding of decimal fractions, learning how they relate to whole numbers and simple fractions.

They will also explore prime numbers, as well as multiples and factors, helping to strengthen their number knowledge and mental maths skills.

Science

This term in Science, Year 5 will be exploring two fascinating topics. First, we will be learning about Animals including humans, where children will investigate how humans develop over their lifespan. They will also be learning about gestational periods and how they vary across a variety of animals.

Later in the term, we will move on to Forces, where children will explore different types of forces, including gravity, air resistance, water resistance, and friction. They will also carry out practical investigations to deepen their understanding of how forces affect the way objects move.

PE

This term, children will continue to develop key skills of resilience, tactics and game sense.

This will be incorporated through rugby, cricket, athletics and orienteering.

English

During this term, we will be covering the following genres:

- Non-Chronological Report - A report about an Arctic animal.
- Narrative - Fantasy story based upon the short animation 'The Fantastic Flying Books of Morris Lessmore'

RE

The units of work this term will be focused on Christianity and Islam. Our focus questions are , 'Why is it sometimes difficult to do the right thing?' and 'Why is the Qur'an important to Muslims'.



Music

In music we will be learning about composition notation and the Blues.

Design & Technology

Children will be using their baking skills to bake savory biscuits.

Art

In art, we will be learning about using different types of typography to create a map of a magical, mythical place.

History

Our new topic is the Anglo-Saxons. There is a lot to cover including:

- Where the Anglo-Saxons originated from
- Why they settled in Britain
- What daily life was like for an Anglo-Saxon
- Who Alfred the Great was

The children will also be developing their historical skills including, chronology enquiry and interpreting sources and communication.

Geography

The class will be developing their field work knowledge about the local area with a focus on Lancashire. Within this unit they will use their map skills to investigate the key features of our county.

Computing

In computing, Year 5 will be looking at computing systems and how search results are generated. They will also be using the micro:bits to have a go at some physical computing later in the term.
